Introduction. For the rest of the paper, please use Times Roman (Times New Roman) 12. This document explains and demonstrates how to prepare your camera-ready abstract for the Book of Abstract of the conference Materials Structure & Micromechanics of Fracture. The best is to read these instructions and follow the outline of this text. The text area for your manuscript must be 17 cm wide and 25 cm high (6.7 and 9.8 inches, resp.). Do not place any text outside this area (please do not change the document setting from A4 to letter). Your manuscript will be reduced by approximately 20% by the publisher. Please keep this in mind when designing your figures and tables etc.

All manuscripts must be in English. Should authors use tables or figures from other Publications, they must ask the corresponding publishers to grant them the right to publish this material in their paper.

Use *italic* for emphasizing a word or phrase. Do not use boldface typing or capital letters except for section headings (cf. remarks on section headings, below).

Extent: Abstract Booklet should contain one abstract on each page, please make therefore the *best layout of the whole A4 page*.

MSWord document styles. This template contains 11 styles marked by self-explaining names, prepared for an easy formatting the text. The abstract should contain only parts formatted by following styles: *MSMF Title, MSMF Author(s), MSMF Address, MSMF Keywords, MSMF Abstract (MSMF Equation, MSMF Reference).* Do not type "Abstract" at the start of the main text.

Section headings are typed as part of the succeeding paragraph (like the section heading of this paragraph). You need not use sections in this Abstract.

Summary. The abstract should be prepared in the electronic form as a standard document format DOC, and suitable text editor (as MS Word) should be used. The abstract is to be submitted by using the MSMF registration form (web http://msmf.fme.vutbr.cz). We strongly recommend to convert the electronic version into the PDF format and to send *both DOC and PDF versions* to the Organizing Committee. If you cannot prepare the PDF version, a print-out of the valid electronic version should be made and sent to the Organizing Committee by surface mail.
